




Jobs Generated by Cloud Computing

In January 2008, Amazon announced that the <u>Amazon Web Services</u> consume more bandwidth than its entire global network of <u>Amazon.com</u> retail sites









iOS v. Android - The Numbers Vary









Almost All Tablet Owners Download Apps



Mobile/Gaming...

- The mobile gaming industry is predicted to reach \$54 Billion by 2015
- 84% of tablet owners play games
- 70 80% of all mobile downloads are games
- Android is soon to overtake Apple in number of total available apps
- In-game purchases should overtake pay-per-downloads by 2013
- Developers made \$87 million in ad revenue in 2010 and will grow 10 fold by 2015




